The project is based on non-formal education, sharing of good practices, and peer-to-peer learning.

The idea of this project was inspired by our past projects. And through this training course, we want to offer participants a space for learning and sharing their experiences.

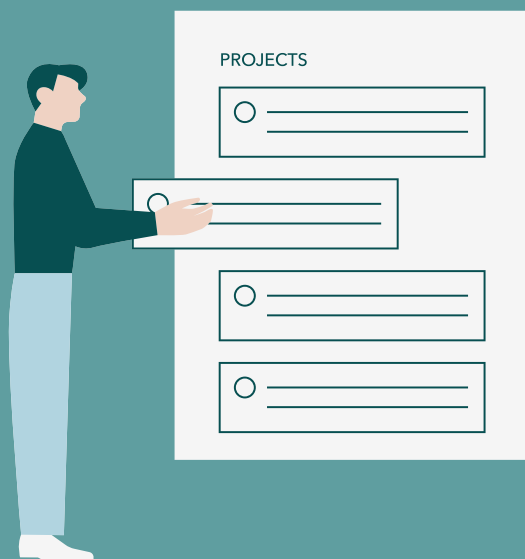
In Solve It! we aim to bring knowledge and skills to youth workers and young people who would like to or are actively working in the field of youth.

# OBJECTIVES

1) Informing and training participants about problem-solving and crisis management, with the aim of raising the quality of their work with youth and building a safer environment in Erasmus+ projects for youth.

2) To develop problem-solving skills among trainers and workers with youth participating on the training course in order to build resilience in case of crisis situation, and therefore better their satisfaction in their job and prevent professional burnout.

3) To identify and address the challenges that our participants might face in their work with youth - including (cyber)bullying, sexual harassment, and cultural misunderstandings and arguments.

4) To create space for sharing knowledge and exchanging experiences and good practices in order to develop a communication plan to resolve different potential situations.

5) To connect a group of workers with youth and build an international community specialized in resolving problems occurring during work with youth.



# A C T I V I T I E S

During the Training course the **non-formal education** techniques will be used, including **workshops with experts, sharing best practices, and peer-to-peer learning**. These methods are chosen to encourage active participation and enhance the learning experience.

Participants will have the opportunity to reflect on their daily learning experiences throughout the project. By actively engaging in the creation of the **booklet**, they can strengthen their knowledge and gain a deeper understanding of the topics covered. This reflective process will contribute to their personal and professional growth as youth workers.

The TC will foster an environment beneficial for learning and knowledge sharing among youth workers and NGOs. Through **collaboration** between participants, experts, and the project team, the **booklet** will be created. It will focus on practical situations to support and empower youth workers in their work. The emphasis will be on upskilling, equipping them with the necessary tools and knowledge to handle these situations with resilience and expertise in the future.

Together, we strive to empower and support youth workers in their important work with resilience and confidence.



# PARTICIPANT PROFILE

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- Someone who is working directly with youth such as youth workers, counselors, trainers, etc.
- Someone who has a good understanding of the diverse challenges which could happen while working with youth.
- Someone who is willing to get inspired by youth work methodologies and tools of different types of management and tries to apply them to their context.
- Someone willing to challenge themselves and take further initiative.
- Someone empathetic who is prepared to work on heavy topics and afterward uses their knowledge to make Erasmus+ training courses a safe and healthy environment.
- Youth workers planning to launch, develop, or scale-up international youth projects and follow-up activities.
- Someone who is eager to be involved in this project and participate actively and be willing and open to contribute to mutual work.

Participants will be selected independently of their race, color, sexual orientation, gender, disability, political orientation, and beyond.

We would like to invite people interested in this topics with a communicative level of English. Minimum age is 18 years old. The applicant should be someone associated with a sending organization, volunteer, or a person whose studies are associated with the topic of the project.

The applicant doesn't have to have experiences but has to be interested in the topic, and be supported from the sending organization to proceed with dissemination after the project.



# T R A V E L I N F O R M A T I O N

PLEASE REMEMBER, ONLY THE MOST ECONOMICAL TRANSPORTATION WILL BE REIMBURSED.

**\*You can take 2 extra days before or after the project.\***



30 EUR will be used for the local transportation in the Czech Republic. Accommodation, transportation and food will be fully covered with the support of Erasmus+ programme.

The travel costs will be reimbursed for the cheapest and direct way of transport and only under the condition that the participant will take part in the whole project. **The travel costs will be reimbursed according to amounts stated in the chart.**

It is necessary for the participants to have travel health insurance (this is not covered by the project).

## TRAVEL TIPS

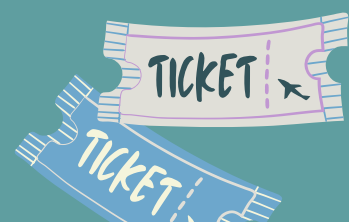
Plan your trip well and choose the best means of transportation. Especially short distance can be often covered by a bus or a train, and flights can be avoided. Travel light, take only as much as you really need.

You can take 2 extra day before or after the project. **However**, we would like to ask you to look for flights that **will be arriving NO later than 2:30pm on October 22, 2023**. And **returning flights that will be NOT before 2pm October 31, 2023**.

**REMEMBER to send us a proposal of your tickets before buying them.**

**It is necessary that we will APPROVE them first!**

**Keep invoices of the purchases and boarding passes and tickets** so we could reimburse them for you.



# GREEN TRAVEL



Plan your trip well and choose the best means of transportation. Especially short distance can often covered by a bus or a train and flights can be avoided. Travel light, take only as much as you really need.

The Erasmus+ program offers **Green Travel Support** for people travelling to their destination using sustainable modes of transport - car-pooling, a bus or a train. To qualify for Green Travel Support, you must use sustainable means of transport for at least half of your journey (outward and return).

Green Travel Support is available if your destination lies within 100 km to 4000 km travel distance. If you receive Green Travel Support, **you will receive a higher travel allowance** than the standard travel allowance. And the funded travel duration **will be increased** from maximum of 2 days to **maximum of 4 days**.

## from Vienna to Pardubice

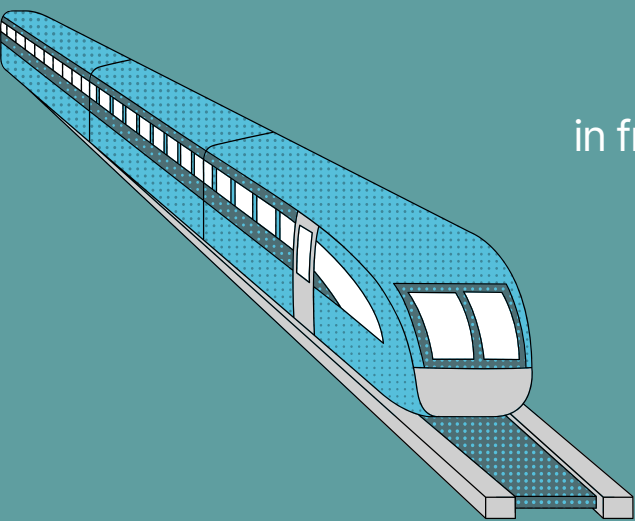
The train is going from Vienna Main Train Station. You can buy your tickets either online or in person at the station. The ticket should cost around 5€.

# MEETING POINT

The meeting point will be in front of the main train station in Pardubice, by the entrance into the building on **October 22, 2023 at 6pm.**



## Two ways to get from the airport to the Prague train station:



01

Participants who will be landing at the Václav Havel Airport Prague (Letiště Václava Havla Praha) can take **bus 199 or 322** at the bus stop in front of terminal 1 or terminal 2 which will go to Nádraží Veleslavín. Then you need to switch to Metro green line A and get off at the stop **Muzeum**. From here it is either 5 minutes walk to the train station or switch to Metro red line C and continue

stop to Hlavní Nádraží. You can buy a 40-minute ticket at the bus stop in the ticket vending machine.

02

You can take AE bus that will take you straight to the Prague train station Hlavní Nádraží. The ticket costs 100 czk and you can buy it at the bus driver, it is possible to pay in cash or by a card.

At the train station you take a train to Pardubice hl.n. The journey takes an hour to reach Pardubice. The meeting point will be **in front of the middle entrance into the building latest by 6pm.**

## **Questions:**

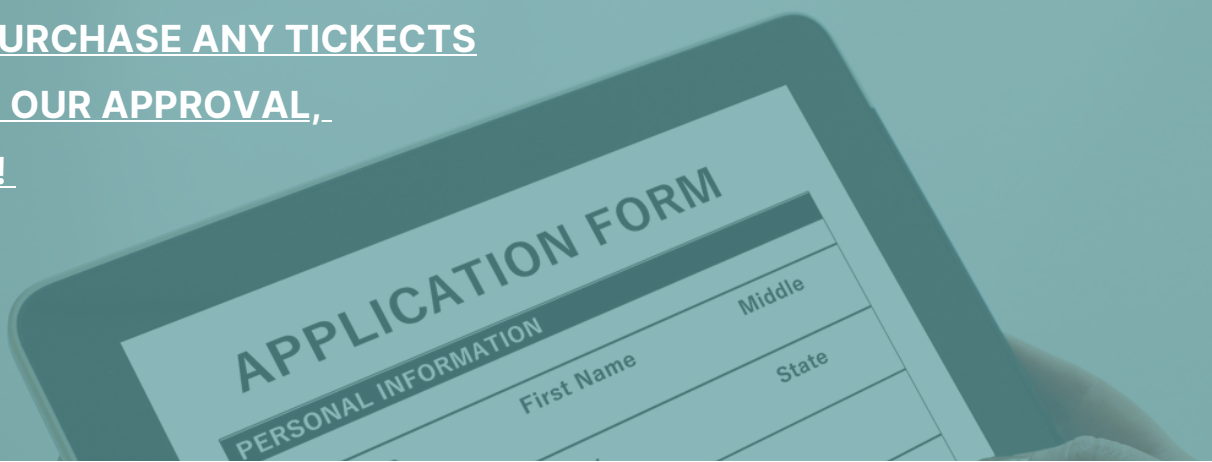
1. What is your experience with the crisis management?

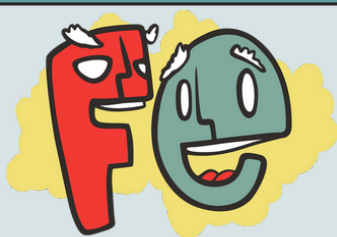
Genesis is a Czech non-governmental organization with a long tradition and simple philosophy.

# WEATHER AND WHAT TO BRING

## WEATHER

In October, the temperatures continue to cool down, so by the end of the month the average temperatures are 5°C during the day and 2°C after dark.



October can be rainy so we recommend that you check the weather forecast in the Czech Republic before the departure and adjust your selection of clothes to it.
